



## Post GCSE Advice and Guidance

### Collecting your results

Examination results are available to collect from the Hall between 9am and 11am on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> August. Please ensure that anyone collecting on your behalf has written permission from you to do so and has photo ID.

### Enquiries about results

Please read the information about how to request a re-mark or other exam board services carefully. This is included with your exam results and is on the website. Priority re-marks are only available for A2 candidates – for GCSE students we do advise that you discuss the advisability of a re-mark with your teacher before applying for one. It may be that even if the result in one paper is improved, this will make no difference overall to your grade. You should also be aware that grades can go down as well as up and you should check how close to you are to the grade boundary before going ahead.

### Sixth Form Enrolment deadline

If you are returning to 6<sup>th</sup> Form, please ensure that you return the confirmation form to the box outside the north entrance to the main building by the deadline of 10am on Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> August. The box will be available from results day. Do remember that the school gates are closed over the weekend and on the bank holiday. If we do not get a form back by this deadline, we have to assume that you have decided not to take up your place and will release the spaces we have reserved for you on your chosen courses. This means that we cannot guarantee that there will be a space for you on your preferred courses should you subsequently get in touch and want to take up a place.

### Getting advice

Miss McCrorie and Mr de Kort will be available on GCSE results day to answer any questions regarding Sixth Form enrolment and there will also be subject staff around to answer queries. Mrs Duffy from Connexions will be available for students who need advice regarding college options. If you have issues regarding your chosen courses at Beaumont and need some advice you are welcome to attend a drop-in session in the Library from 9.30-12.00 on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> August. There is no need to come if you want to change a course and do not need any advice - please just indicate this on your enrolment form. It is unlikely, in any case, that we will be able to confirm any course changes before the enrolment day, 2<sup>nd</sup> September. Many courses are full and we will only be able to ascertain where spaces have been freed up once we have all the forms back and they have been processed.

Please do not try to get in touch using the school admin email or by calling the main number. The office is not staffed during the holidays and your message will not be received until term starts.

Whilst staff are in school on August 26<sup>th</sup> to process confirmation forms, we hope you understand that this is a lengthy process and we are unable to meet with students and parents on that day. If you need to speak to anyone about your Sixth Form courses, you must therefore do so on either results day or during the drop-in session the day afterwards.

**Entry criteria**

Please check carefully that you have met the entry criteria for your chosen courses. These are in your Sixth Form prospectus or can be downloaded from the Beaumont or BeauSandVer websites. If you have not met the published criteria for one of your chosen courses, please ensure you indicate an alternative course choice for which you do meet the criteria on your confirmation form.
