Re: Drama visit to the Gielgud Theatre – The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-time – Monday 12th September 2016

We have obtained tickets to see the highly acclaimed Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-time at the Gielgud Theatre. This is being offered to Year 11 Drama students. GCSE students need to write a theatre review as part of their course so they need to see the production.

The cost of this trip will be £25 including the ticket and transport. Unfortunately, we are unable to meet these costs from our own funds, and the visit will only be able to go ahead if parents are prepared to make a voluntary contribution of £25 to school funds. It is entirely up to you whether you wish to contribute. However, if all parents are not prepared to make this contribution then the visit may not be able to take place for any of the students.

I should be grateful if you would complete the reply slip and return it to me as soon as possible, cheques to be made payable to Beaumont School. You can send your money or cheque in a sealed envelope with your son/daughter's name, form and title of the trip clearly written on it. This should be placed in the box marked 'Curious Incident' outside the Finance Office by **Monday 6th June**. Alternatively you can make payment over the internet using our online payment system (NB: You must still return the consent slip to school by the deadline).

We will be travelling there and back by coach. Students are to meet outside school at 5.00pm. We estimate that we will return to the Quadrant, Marshalswick by approximately 11.00pm but students should bring their mobile phones where possible so as to contact parents on the way home.
