The cost of this trip will be £24 including the ticket and transport. We will be travelling there and back by coach. Students are to meet outside school at 5.00pm. We estimate that we will return to the Quadrant, Marshalswick by approximately 11.00pm but students should bring their mobile phones where possible so as to contact parents on the way home.
