#### **Election of Parent Governors**

Five nominations have been received for the two Parent Governor vacancies and the names of these parents are listed overleaf, together with their personal statements. Each parent in the school is entitled to vote and, as there are two vacancies, each parent is invited to register two votes on the ballot paper.

Only the parents of a pupil currently registered at the school may vote. For the purpose of the election of a Parent Governor, "Parent" is defined for the purposes of the Constitution Regulations as including "any individual who has or has had parental responsibility for, or cares or has cared for, a child or young person under the age of 19." It includes a person who the child lives with or who looks after the child, irrespective of what their relationship is with the child. The reference in the definition must be someone involved in the full-time care of the child on a settled basis.

### Instructions:

- 1. Place an 'X' against up to two names on the ballot sheet overleaf (one vote per candidate).
- 2. Put the completed ballot sheet into a blank envelope and seal it. Please do not sign the ballot paper or this first envelope.
- 3. Put this envelope into a second envelope.
- 4. On the second envelope write your name in BLOCK LETTERS, plus the names of all of your children attending Beaumont and their form groups, and your signature.
- 5. Please return the envelope to the school office by the closing date. We will record the fact that you have voted to ensure eligibility and then place the unmarked envelope in the ballot

The closing date for the return of ballot papers is 10.00am on Thursday 17 November 2016 and the count will take place immediately afterwards in the presence of a Governor of the school.

Where two ballot papers are to be returned from the same household (ie two parents are voting) please treat each ballot paper separately as above. The school will check all envelopes to ensure eligibility and the plain envelopes will then be opened and counted. In this way a secret ballot of eligible parents occurs. Please make additional copies of the ballot paper as required i.e. one ballot paper per parent. Please contact the school if you are unable to print/copy the ballot form.

The names of the successful candidates will be posted on the school website and will be communicated to parents in Beaumont Life.
