Bletchley Park Trip, Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2017

The Computer Science Department has organised an educational trip to Bletchley Park, in Milton Keynes, on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2017. This multi-award winning venue is the site where Alan Turing and his team of codebreakers deciphered the German Enigma code during the World War II. The programme for the day include workshops, demonstrations and tours that are not open to the general public and are designed to be inspirational to all students. This trip will provide an invaluable experience to both our GCSE and Sixth Form students.

We will leave school at 8.30am and return back to school at approximately 3.30pm. The cost of the trip will be £22 which covers travel by coach and the entrance ticket. Unfortunately, we are unable to meet these costs from our own funds, and the visit will only be able to go ahead if parents are prepared to make a voluntary contribution of £22 to school funds. It is entirely up to you whether you wish to contribute. However, if all parents are not prepared to make this contribution then the visit may not be able to take place for any of the children.

Please complete and return the attached slip together with £22 (cheques made payable to Beaumont School) **by no later than Friday 17<sup>th</sup> March 2017**. You should send your money or cheque in a sealed envelope with your son/daughter's name, form and title of the trip clearly written on it. **This should be posted in the appropriate box outside the Finance Office.** Alternatively you can pay over the Internet. If the trip is oversubscribed by this date, places will be allocated by lottery. In the event of your son/daughter not getting a place, any monies paid will be returned.
