WHAT DO STUDENTS STUDY FOR KEY STAGE 3 ART?

Students will cover a range of topics including:

- Formal elements
- Flora & Fauna
- Pop Art
- Portraiture
- Urban Art
- Typography

They use a range of materials (2D and 3D) and learn to create artwork with different techniques and processes including painting, printing and ceramics.

HOW MUCH HOME LEARNING DO STUDENTS RECEIVE?

Students will be given a task every two or three weeks which is based on the work that has been started in the lesson. The home learning will be to complete it.

DO THEY NEED ANY ART MATERIALS?

We provide most of the specialist equipment but it is very useful to have a range of tonal pencils and good quality colour pencils to support home learning tasks.

IS ART POPULAR?

Yes it is very popular with three different art courses running across Key Stage 4 and 5. We offer GCSE Art and Design and Art Graphics together with A Level in Art and Design and also in Photography.
