We pride ourselves on offering an extensive, varied programme of extra-curricular activities at Beaumont. We run a number of unauditioned groups, so students of all abilities can get involved, as well as auditioned ensembles. We perform in a number of concerts every year, and our flagship ensembles have performed at the Royal Albert Hall, as well as Hatfield House for Her Majesty the Queen. We often collaborate with local and national choirs and ensembles, and run a Music tour to Europe every two years.

ARE INDIVIDUAL INSTRUMENTAL LESSONS AVAILABLE?

Individual lessons are available on most instruments. Instrumental tuition is provided by an outstanding team of teachers from Hertfordshire Music Service. Students have lessons during the day, using a rota system (lessons are a different time each week). There is an additional charge for instrumental lessons, but a range of financial support is available.
