Ethics

1. Read pages 122-150 'Where do right and wrong come from?' from *The Philosophy Files* by Stephen Law. Complete the following tasks:

- Make a list of things that are wrong in your view.
- Summarise the different ways people know right and wrong.
- Write a paragraph outlining which is the strongest reason in your view and explain why.

Religion

1. Make a list of the things you know about the life and death of Jesus.
2. Read the extract 'Introducing the New Testament: background to the life of Christ' from *Religious Studies* by Sarah K Tyler and Gordon Reid.
3. Make a list of the things you have learnt from the extract.
4. Examine and comment on the religious meaning of three of the titles of Jesus.
