We also have a really handy journey planner app called the **Arriva Bus app**, that can be used to plan a journey. All you need to do is enter your home postcode and the schools postcode and the app will do the rest – easy!



Ticket options

We have a range of child tickets available to suit everyone from Day tickets for occasional travel to Annual tickets for those travelling everyday. These tickets are available for those under 16 or up to the end of year 11. All Zone Shires offers travel across all our bus services shown on the map overleaf.

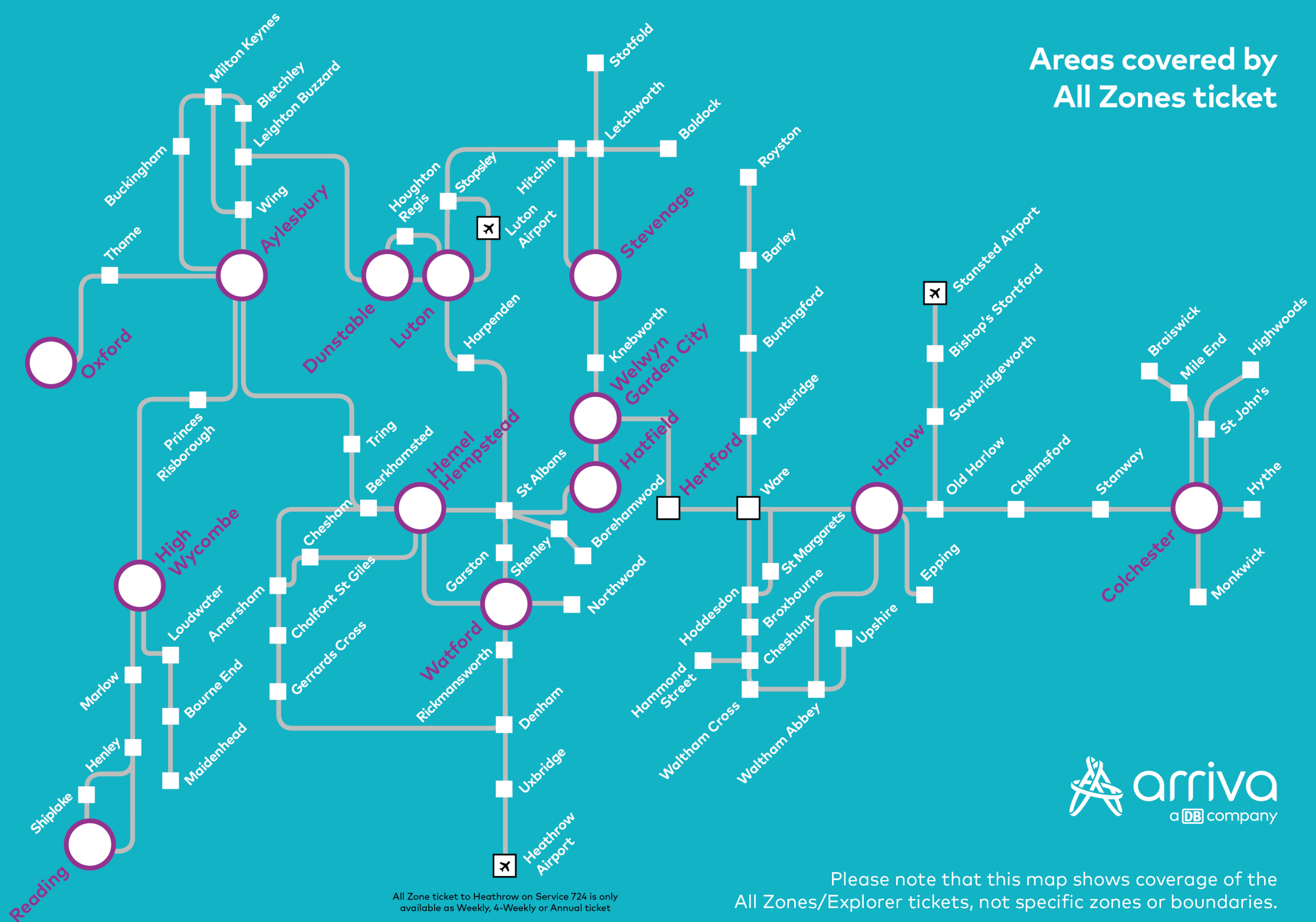


All Zone Shires child annual tickets can be paid monthly via direct debit for £49.17 per month, see arrivabus.co.uk/ss-hertsessex for more details

How to use the bus

Catching the bus can be a fun way of travelling to and from school, but it is important to be aware of how to ride a bus in a way that makes everyone's journey a safe and enjoyable one.

1



When waiting at the bus stop **stand well away from the road** and show respect for others

2



Hold out your hand when you are at a bus stop to indicate you wish the bus to stop

3



Let people off the bus before you try to board

4



Have your **fare/pass** or **m-ticket** ready to pay/show the driver

5



Take a seat if there is one free, if not stand and **hold on tight to a handrail**

6



Push the **STOP** button just before your stop – but **only push it once!**

Top tips

Here are some useful tips for catching the bus that can make your journey easier

1



Practice taking your journey to school, maybe during the summer so that you know which bus stops to get on and off at

2



Plan ahead and check bus times with the Arriva Bus app

3



Keep your ticket/pass safe – keep it in the same place each time you put it away

4



If the bus is full, **give up your seat** to a vulnerable passenger.
