Dear Parents/Carers

On Monday 29 June we should have been starting our Curriculum Enrichment Week. Memorable trips at home and abroad can no longer take place and Year 10 Work Experience has also had to be cancelled. We will however still be offering an opportunity for our students to complete enrichment activities during this week. Details for the different year groups are set out below:

YEARS 7-9

Monday 29 and Tuesday 30 June

There will be no lessons for these year groups on these days. Instead, Monday will be a Creativity Enrichment Day offering over 15 different activities for students to choose to complete, many of these will offer a much needed break from screens. There will be an opportunity for students to submit photographs and videos that we can share in the school community to celebrate their work. We will be asking students, should they choose to upload a photograph and/or video, to ensure that they do not include their name or anything that identifies them in the photograph/video itself and that they check with you as their parent/carer prior to submission.

Tuesday will be a Virtual Sports Day. The PE department has created a range of challenges to be completed and live updates will be broadcast during the day to keep students informed of their Form and House progress. We encourage the whole family to get involved if you can.

The activities can be accessed through a new dedicated section of the Distance Learning Portal (<https://learn.beaumont.school/ced>.) In order to give students the time to explore what is on offer and plan their days in advance, we will be making the pages available by no later than Friday 27 June.

Distance learning lessons will then resume for Years 7-9 on Wednesday 1 July.

Year 10

Year 10 students will complete their timetabled day of lessons in school. Then the Creativity Day and Sports Day can be completed on two other days, as outlined above. Virtual Sports Day needs to be completed on Tuesday or Wednesday so that we can publish results before the end of the week. We have also provided activities for a Year 10 Looking Ahead Day, to replace





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their cancelled Work Experience. This will be a chance for students to explore career options and to begin to think about their future choices. Year 10 students will also be set one lesson this week by their MFL and option subject teachers. These will be set on Monday and should be completed by Friday.
