In addition, we expect students to spend 1 hour per week testing themselves/practising their skills for all levelled subjects in the curriculum. It would be best to spread this time out, spending around 20 minutes per sitting. Teachers will give guidance on which activities will work best and may provide resources like knowledge organisers/practice booklets for students to use.
