## **Re: Cuffley Camp Trip – Tuesday 11 May 2021**

Following Year 7's return to school, I wanted to start by paying tribute to the excellent way in which they have responded to being here on site for face-to-face teaching. It has been a pleasure to welcome them back and I hope your child has enjoyed the term so far.

In line with the government's roadmap and the Coronavirus regulations, I am delighted to inform you that it is our intention to offer Year 7 the opportunity to visit Cuffley Camp. We have reserved places for students to complete an exciting day of team building activities and hope very much that all students will be able to enjoy this important part of their first year at Beaumont.

The trip is scheduled for **Tuesday 11 May 2021**, all being well following the government announcement on Monday 12 April, and will provide students with the opportunity to complete a series of outdoor activities that will develop their leadership and communication skills, and help them bond as a form group. We have carefully designed the day to achieve these aims and we are confident that this will form an important part of their first year at secondary school.

We shall travel to the venue via coach and shall meet in school for registration as usual before departing. Students will be provided with lunch (pizza) on the day, but should bring along a drink, snack and a packed lunch if not wanting pizza. Students should wear appropriate clothing for outdoor activities and the weather conditions. Specific details will be provided to students in an assembly nearer the time. We anticipate returning to the main car park by 4pm and students will be free to leave from there via their normal mode of transport. Students will contact parents on the return journey if we expect to arrive after this time.

The cost of the trip will be £45.50 and this will cover activities at Cuffley Camp and the return travel via coach. Unfortunately, the school is unable to meet the cost of this trip from its own funds so the visit will only be able to go ahead if parents are prepared to pay a voluntary contribution. Please note if all parents are not prepared to make the contribution, then the visit may not be able to take place for any of the students. If you are in receipt of income support or other benefits it may be possible for some financial assistance to be provided. Parents/carers who wish to discuss financial assistance towards this contribution should contact the Finance Office before applying for the trip.

The school's preferred method of payment is through our online payment system that can be accessed via the School Portal on the front page of the Beaumont School website or at [www.scopay.com/beaumont](http://www.scopay.com/beaumont). Here you are also able to give permission electronically for your child to participate in the trip and advise us of any medical conditions or allergies, therefore deeming it not necessary to return the paper permission slip below. The trip will be launched, with this method of payment being made available, from Tuesday 13 April 2021 dependent on the government guidance remaining, and a notification will be sent.
