Re: Year 10 and 11 GCSE Drama trip to Woman in Black - Thursday 30 September 2021

As part of the GCSE Drama course, students need to see live theatre as they will be writing a live theatre review as part of their GCSE exam. We have had the good fortune to secure tickets for the brilliant and long-running production of **Woman in Black** at The Fortune Theatre, London on Thursday 30 September 2021.

We will be travelling there and back by coach and students are required to meet at the main school entrance to the A block at 5:20pm where the transport will leave promptly 10 minutes after, please ensure your child arrives on time. We estimate that we will return to the school car park for approximately 11:30pm, however students should bring their mobile phones where possible so they can contact parents on the way home with our ETA. Your child will need to have eaten before the trip and/or bring some money for a snack when at the theatre.

The cost of the trip will be £28 and classified as an optional extra, the school is therefore entitled to charge for it.

The school's method of payment is through our online payment system that can be accessed via the School Portal on the front page of the Beaumont School website or at <u>www.scopay.com/beaumont</u>. Payment should be made, and consent received by **Tuesday 6 July 2021.** If you experience any problems in making an online payment please do contact us by email – <u>tripsandvisits@beaumont.school</u> to assist with this.

Please be sure to check the medical condition and allergies information, and the emergency contact details we hold for your child on your 'My Child at School' account are correct and advise us of any changes.

Please be advised if the trip is oversubscribed and it proves necessary to create a selection process, places will be allocated through a lottery process. In the event of your child not securing a place the monies paid will of course be returned.
