Final Details Thorpe Park Trip - Thursday 1 July

Dear Parent/Guardian

I hope that your child is enjoying the summer and is looking forward to the trip.

On Tuesday 29 June, all students who are attending the Thorpe Park trip must have a Lateral Flow Test. Test kits will be available from school reception prior to this date. As when your child was attending school, please log the results both on the NHS site and on the school google form. Both of these links are below:

If they get a positive result please also inform the school by emailing admin@beaumont.school, and follow self-isolation guidance. If you experience any issues logging on the school google form, we would be very grateful if you could try again at a different time or email the result to finance@beaumont.school.

On arrival at school on 1 July via Austen Way, students will line up beside A Block at 8.15am. Before they go to the form room, they had in A Block, their temperature will be taken and their hands sanitised. If a student has a temperature, they will not be able to take part in the trip. Thorpe Park will also be taking each person's temperature on arrival and if a person is found to have a temperature, no members from the school party will be allowed to enter the site.

Once this has been completed, they will go to their form room to register. Please ensure that they have a mask as they will be required to be worn whenever students are in an indoor venue, including on the coach journey.

Dress is casual, although we would urge pupils to dress appropriately for the event and be mindful of the fact that they will still be representing the school.

We would like to reiterate the importance of excellent behaviour on the day of the trip. Should alcohol or any other banned substance be found in a student's possession, or should a student be suspected of their consumption at any time (including prior to attending school), the student will not be allowed to take any further part in the visit. If students wish to take water on the visit, we ask that they bring an empty bottle to school on the day of the trip, which will be filled at school prior to boarding the coach. **No other liquid will be allowed on the coaches.** Alternatively, water can be bought at Thorpe Park. In addition, we may need to search students' belongings prior to leaving school and Thorpe Park may wish to search bags on arrival. Therefore, we ask parents/carers to discuss with pupils anything that they are taking with them, to ensure that it is appropriate. Pupils should bring either a packed lunch or money to purchase lunch whilst at Thorpe Park. We also strongly recommend that your child brings sun cream and a hat.



Every student will check in with a member of staff at a designated place and time in the middle part of the day (12.30pm-1.30pm). We will also be taking a note of students' mobile numbers whilst they are on the trip.

We will be leaving Thorpe Park at 3pm and are aiming to arrive back at school by 4.30pm (depending on traffic).

I look forward to seeing your child on 1 July.
