

## Politics Summer Work

Between now and September we would like you to be working on the following projects to help you get a grounding in all things political!

### 1. Prepare for a test on the following:

a) Keywords for Democracy and Participation unit (see attached)

b) You will need to be able to name at least 2 referendums that have taken place in the UK; the date they were held, what the question was and why it was held.

b) You will also need to critically analyse the **impact** of each of the referendums you choose to look at (*there is a clue as to what we mean by impact in the cartoon to the side*).



### 2. To show that you have been following the political news over the summer holidays we want you to bring in 4 articles that you have found relating to UK politics.

They can be cut outs from a newspaper or print outs from the internet. Be prepared to discuss why you have picked them as relevant to UK politics. For each article complete the following:

- Title, Author, Date, and why you think the article is interesting.
