



During Year 7, some subjects will normally set home learning tasks on a weekly basis. The timetable below shows which subjects will do this and when the tasks will be set. In addition, we expect students to spend 1 hour per week testing themselves/practising their skills for all levelled subjects in the curriculum.

It would be best to spread this time out, spending around 20 minutes per sitting. Teachers will give guidance on which activities will work best and may provide resources like knowledge organisers/practice booklets for students to use. We would also encourage all students to take part in our rich programme of extra-curricular activities.
