Re: US Politics Today Conference

Date: Monday 15th November 2021

Venue: Conference Centre, British Library, St Pancras, London

Time: 10:30am-3:30pm

The Politics department is organising an exciting curriculum enhancement visit to London to attend a politics student conference at the British Library. The conference will include a series of speakers, of which two (2) are former members of Congress. Students will get to listen to how, both a Republican and a Democrat Congressman or woman, view their own political system.

Students will be responsible for their own travel arrangements to and from the conference. **Students will need to arrive at the venue for 10:15am to be registered by the teacher.** Please ensure your child arrives in good time.

The cost of the trip will be £19 and this will cover the ticket entrance to the venue only, it does however also include a buffet lunch in the price. Therefore, students are required to bring enough money to cover their travel and food and drink for the day if they wish to eat something different to that which is served as part of the buffet lunch.

As a school we strive to ensure the safety of our students, staff and their families and encourage all those participating in a trip to complete and log twice-weekly lateral flow tests. We also recommend that face masks are worn on public transport.

Unfortunately, the school is unable to meet the cost of this trip from its own funds so the visit will only be able to go ahead if parents are prepared to pay a voluntary contribution. Please note, if all parents are not prepared to make the contribution the visit may not be able to take place for any of the students. If you would like your child to participate in this trip/event but will experience difficulty in making the contribution then please contact the Finance Office before signing up to the trip using the email below.

The school's method of payment for trips is through your child's 'My Child at School' (MCaS) account, which can also be accessed via the School Portal on the front page of the Beaumont School website. Payment should be made and consent received by **Sunday 31st October**. If you experience any problems in making an online payment please contact the Finance office by email – finance@beaumont.school to assist with this.
