Dear Parent/Guardian

## **Re: Year 9 Personal Development (PD) Week – Monday 4 – Wednesday 6 July 2022**

Following the success of previous year's activities provided during what was previously known as Curriculum Enrichment Week, we shall again be offering students the opportunity to choose from a 3-day residential trip to PGL or to select from a range of daily activities held both in-school and offsite. At this time, we are only asking students to select if they would like to take part in the residential trip or if they would prefer to stay in school, for which more information will follow later.

### **Residential Trip**

The 3-day Residential Trip to PGL is open to all Year 9 students and will cost in the region of between £280 and £320, dependent on numbers attending. If your child decides to go to PGL, you must sign up to the trip on your child's 'My Child at School' (MCaS) account and pay a non-refundable deposit of £50 by no later than **Friday 15 October 2021** to secure a place.

*Please note; once your child has been allocated a place on a trip you will be required to pay the full cost of the trip even if you or your child, subsequently change your mind about participating. We will of course make our best endeavours to mitigate the cost to you in these circumstances however we will be entering into contracts with tour operators and/or travel companies based on your request for a place, and you will be liable for any charges which are payable under that contract.*
