## **Re: Personal Development Week Trip to PGL – Monday 4 to Friday 8 July 2022**

During our Personal Development Week (PDW) this year we are unable to take our Year 7s away to France and Germany due to the ever changing restrictions and have therefore secured, and would like to offer them the opportunity to participate in a Year 7 activity week away in Perthshire, Scotland. Throughout the week, the children will participate in a number of onsite activities in smaller groups with a staff member and onsite activity leader.

The trip will cost between £390 and £420 depending on the numbers participating. The cost of the trip includes a voluntary contribution towards activities and transport and a charge for board and lodging. If insufficient pupils are prepared to pay the voluntary contribution, then the trip may have to be cancelled for all pupils.

If you would like your child to participate in this enjoyable and valuable trip, please so sign up to the trip on your child's 'My Child at School' (MCaS) account and pay a non-refundable deposit of £50 by no later than **Thursday 4 November 2021** to secure a place.

*Please note that once your child has been allocated a place on this trip the school will be entering into a contract with tour operators and/or travel companies based on your request for a place and you will be liable for any cancellation charges which are payable under that contract should you or your child, subsequently change your mind about participating.*

Please be sure to check the medical condition and allergies information, and the emergency contact details we hold for your child on your 'My Child at School' account are correct and advise us of any changes.

I would like to draw your attention to the school Trips and Visits Procedure that is available on the school website. This requires all pupils participating in school visits to have a good record of behaviour at school. Please note that mobile phones and electronic internet capable devices are **NOT** permitted on Residential Trips and if a student is found to have one it shall be confiscated. There will be regular updates for you as parents/carers via a form of social networking from the trip leader.
