End of Year 11 information

As we move into the final few days of school for our Year 11 students, we would be grateful if you could take the time to **reread** the following important information regarding arrangements in school and key dates.

Shirt Signing - Wednesday 11 May 2022

In the afternoon on the above date, students will gather to be able to sign shirts. Students will then be dismissed during period 7 on that day.

Thorpe Park Trip - Thursday 12 May 2022 8.15am

Please refer to the letter that was sent out previously regarding the Thorpe Park trip. A reminder that those students who are not attending the trip will be required to attend school in uniform where they will be able to complete work to prepare for their forthcoming exams.

Graduation Ceremony - Thursday 12 May 2022 7pm

Thank you for your responses to the invite to the above event. Unfortunately, we can only offer a maximum of one guest per student, due to the limited space in the school hall. As we have had a very high response to the evening, we cannot offer any ballot places for extra tickets per student. The ceremony will be followed by some light refreshments in the Sixth Form atrium and there will be the opportunity for groups of friends and families to have photographs taken in the adjacent Sixth Form common room. Students will need to attend the evening in full school uniform, looking as smart as possible to celebrate their graduation from secondary education.

Study Leave – Friday 13 May 2022

Study leave commences on the above date. If you wish your child to remain in school to complete their study leave, please contact me. A room will be made available in school for this to happen.

Attendance at school for exams

Students are expected to wear full school uniform whenever they are on the school premises until the end of the exam period. Please remind them to arrive in plenty of time for their exams with all the necessary equipment. A general timetable for all exams has been posted on the school website and students will receive a personal timetable with venues.

Year 11 Clearance

It is hoped that all students will have been able to complete their 'clearance' from Year 11 by 27 May 2022. The following actions need to be fulfilled by 27 May in order to confirm there are no outstanding items in their possession:

- Locker key (if one has been loaned this year) will need to be handed in to their form tutor (or pay £5 if the key has been lost).
- Library Books need to be returned or £3 to cover the cost of its replacement.
- Technology textbooks need to be returned to Mrs Kadlott.

Sixth Form Induction - Wednesday 29 June - Thursday 30 June

Attendance at the Sixth Form Induction days is compulsory for all students who have applied to Beaumont. Further information regarding this will be sent out in due course by Mrs Tolley, Head of Sixth Form. Those who have applied to Sixth Form at Beaumont will not be required to attend school from Friday 1 July.

Students who are not planning to return to Beaumont in the Sixth Form will not be required to attend school after their final exam.

GCSE Results Day

Results of **GCSE** exams are due to be received in school on **Thursday 25 August**. Students may **EITHER** come in to school to collect their results on this day between **9.00 am** and **11.00 am** or leave an A4 first class stamped and addressed envelope with Mrs Hendricks before the end of term. If a person other than the student is collecting the certificates, they must provide a letter of authorisation signed by the student and bring ID. This includes parents.

Examination certificates are not usually received until **November**. Students who will be leaving school can receive certificates at the Presentation Evening in December or collect them from reception. If a person other than the student comes in to collect the certificates, they must provide a letter of authorisation. Certificates can be sent by **recorded delivery**, but only on request, and at your expense.

If you wish to discuss any of these details, please do not hesitate to contact the Examinations Officer.

POST GCSE Advice

Staff will be available in the hall to speak to students and give advice on results day for any students who need to discuss Sixth Form options post results.
