

Advice and Guidance on GCSE Results Day 2023

and Course Confirmation deadline

This document contains important information. You will need to read this carefully so that you are aware of how to get advice, if you need it, once you receive your GCSE results and how to enrol for the Sixth Form.

Getting advice on GCSE Results day - Thursday 24th August

Staff will be available on GCSE Results day to answer any specific questions regarding Sixth Form enrolment. If, having received your results, you have issues regarding your chosen subjects and need detailed advice, there will be members of LT and the Sixth Form team available to support you. Staff will be available from 09:00 until 13:00. Alison Curnow, our Youth Connexions advisor, will also be available to provide advice and guidance.

If you are currently at another school and have applied to us for Sixth Form, you can also come to the school to seek advice should there be any issues with your results or subject choices. Please report to the <u>Main Reception</u> between 11:00 and 13:00 once you have collected your results from your current school. Please bring a copy of your results with you.

Please note that the Office is not staffed during the holidays and your message may not be received until term starts. The only day to meet for a discussion is on Thursday 24th August between 09:00 and 13:00. Any queries raised after this will be dealt with at Enrolment; please check the website for the timings of this day.

Entry criteria

Once you have received your results, please follow the instructions on your Course Confirmation Form and check carefully that you have met the entry criteria for your chosen subjects These are on the reverse of your offer letter or can be downloaded from the website.

If you have not met the published criteria for one or more of your chosen subjects, please ensure you indicate alternative subject choices, for which you do meet the criteria, on your Course Confirmation Form.

If you want to change a subject, please check that you meet the entry criteria for your new choice and indicate this on your Course Confirmation Form.

Please note that we will not be able to confirm any subject changes before Enrolment on Monday 4th September. Many classes are full and we will only be able to ascertain where spaces have been freed up once we have processed all the forms.

Course Confirmation deadline

Please ensure that you return your completed Course Confirmation Form to the marked box outside Reception by the deadline of 10am on Friday 25th August. You do not have to wait until the deadline to return your form as the box will be available on GCSE Results Day. Alternatively, you can email your completed form to sixthform@beaumont.school by the same deadline.

If we have not received your form by this deadline, we have to assume that you have decided not to take up your place and we will release the spaces reserved for you on your chosen subjects. This means that there may not be available spaces for you, should you subsequently get in touch.
