3 coaches

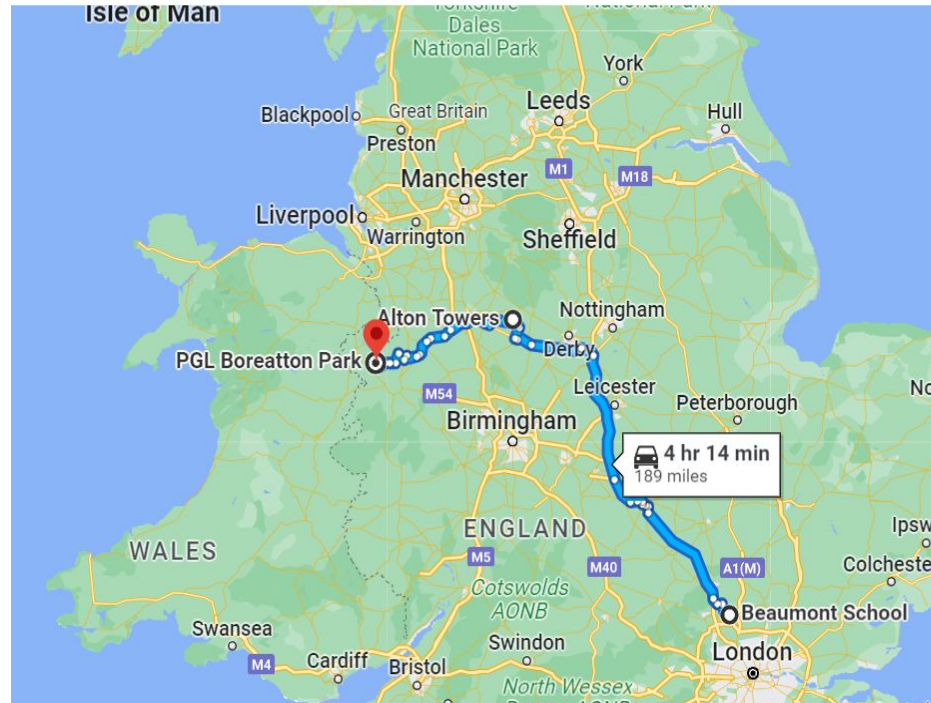
The students will have been informed on the morning of departure which coach they are on.
