Re: French Film GCSE Study Day – Wednesday 24th January 2024

I am delighted to be able to offer Year 10 French GCSE students the opportunity to attend a study day relating to French Film at the British Film Institute, Southbank, London on Wednesday 24th January 2024. This interactive event will be conducted mainly in French and explores elements of the Media aspect of the GCSE Specification. The day has been designed to help students with their understanding of film terminology and to help to prepare them for the writing paper.

We shall travel to the venue by coach leaving school at 9am and returning at approximately 5pm. Students will be required to bring a packed lunch or enough money to cover food and drink for the day. Students will contact parents on the return journey if we expect to arrive after this time.

The cost of the trip will be £32 and this will cover entry to the event and transport to and from the venue. Unfortunately, the school is unable to meet the cost of this trip from its own funds so the visit will only be able to go ahead if parents are prepared to pay a voluntary contribution. Please note if all parents are not prepared to make the contribution then the visit may not be able to take place for any of the students. If you are in receipt of income support or other benefits it may be possible for some financial assistance to be provided.
