
Frequently Asked Questions

When is the Beaumont Sixth Form Open Evening taking place? Thursday 15th January 2026, 5:30-8:00 pm. This is the perfect opportunity to attend subject presentations and meet teachers and Sixth Form students. Please check our [website](#) for more information.

Do I need to book a place? No, please just come along. We look forward to welcoming you to Beaumont School.

I am new to the school, can I visit during the day? Yes, we will be holding morning tours on Wednesday 21st and 28th January by appointment at 9:30am lasting approximately 50-60 mins. The registration link will go live on the [website](#) on the Open Evening.

I have a subject specific question, who should I speak to? Please come along to the Open Evening, where you will have the opportunity to put your questions to subject teachers.

I have a question about the application process, who should I speak to? Firstly, please read through the FAQs as we may have addressed your query here, however, you also have the opportunity to speak to a member of Senior Leadership or Sixth Form Admissions at the Open Evening. Where can I find the application form? The application form link will go live on the [website](#) on the Open Evening.

How can I check that I meet the APS requirement and subject specific entry criteria for the subjects I want to study? Please refer to the [website](#) for the APS pathways and the subject specific entry criteria. Please ensure that you apply for subjects you qualify for at this stage, ie. you need to be within one grade from your mock results and you need to have a minimum APS of 4.

I will not receive my mock results from my current school by the application deadline, what should I do?

Please upload your most current school report and submit your application by the deadline. Please email: sixthform@beaumont.school to let us know you've done this.

Can I apply to more than one school in the BSV Education Trust? No, we can only accept one application per student to the BSV Education Trust. Please do NOT submit duplicate applications as this could put your application at risk.

Can I choose a subject at one of the other two BSV schools? Yes, if you are applying to Beaumont as your home school and a subject you wish to study is not offered here, we will arrange your timetable (option block permitting) to include up to one subject at either Sandringham or Verulam. You cannot choose different schools for different subjects, although we may offer a BSV solution if we encounter a clash with your subjects at Beaumont. For consorting students, we provide BSV minibus travel at morning break and lunchtime, however, you will need to make your own way to and from lessons at the beginning and end of the school day.

When is the deadline for applications? 9am on Friday 6th February 2026 is the equal consideration deadline.

How should I submit my application?

Can I apply after the deadline? We will prioritise all applications received by the deadline before we consider any late applications. Please bear in mind that we may not be able to give late applications equal consideration, as our Sixth Form is very popular and many courses fill up, therefore, do ensure that you submit your application by the 6th February deadline.

What happens after I submit my application? Once the application deadline has passed, we will be in touch with details of what happens next. If you are applying from another school and meet the entry criteria for your subjects, we will invite you to a guidance discussion meeting with a senior member of staff after the February half-term. If you are a Beaumont Year 11 student, you will have your guidance meeting in January.

When will I receive a conditional offer? Conditional offers will be confirmed via Applicaa by the end of the Spring Term.

Do I have to attend the Sixth Form Induction? Yes, attendance at the two-day BSV Sixth Form Induction taking place on 24th and 25th June 2026 is compulsory. The Induction days are an opportunity to experience taster lessons and life in the Sixth Form. We also share key information that will aid transition to KS5 study, so the days are an important part of ensuring a successful start at Beaumont Sixth Form. Students holding a Sixth Form offer will be sent more details of our Induction closer to the time.

What should I do once I have my GCSE results? You need to check that you have met the APS requirement and subject specific entry criteria for your subjects. You will then need to confirm your subject choices via Applicaa by the deadline of 10am on Friday 21st August.

I've changed my mind about one of my subjects, what should I do? Once you've received your GCSE results, you can request a subject change(s) via Applicaa. Please check that you meet the APS requirement and subject specific entry criteria for your new choice(s). Please note, you will only be able to enter subjects for which you meet the entry criteria. Once you have selected another subject, this choice will be reviewed and is subject to available places on the course.

I don't meet the entry criteria for one of my subjects, what should I do? You need to choose a subject that you do meet the entry criteria for on Applicaa. Please note, you will only be able to enter subjects for which you meet the entry criteria. Once you have selected another option, this choice will be reviewed and is subject to available places on the course.

I have my GCSE results and need advice, who should I speak to? Staff will be available at school on GCSE Results Day 20th August 2026 for advice and guidance.

How should I confirm that I wish to take up my Sixth Form place? You need to ensure that you confirm your subject choices by the deadline of 10am Friday 21st August. If you do not complete Applicaa by the deadline, this confirms you have chosen not to take up your Sixth Form place, allowing us to offer it to another student on the waiting list.

Will the school contact me to confirm my Sixth Form place and/or any subject change requests I have made? If everything is in order, we do not routinely contact students, as we will be very busy confirming applications and getting ready for Enrolment. However, we will have to contact you if we cannot accommodate any subject change request(s). Therefore, 1) if you meet the entry criteria for your subjects and have requested no changes, we look forward to seeing you at Enrolment, and 2) if you request a change(s) and meet the entry criteria for your new subject(s) and do not hear from us, we look forward to seeing you at Enrolment.

When should I enrol? Enrolment will take place on Wednesday 2nd September - timings of the day will be posted on the website closer to the time. Among other things, you will meet with your tutor and receive your timetable. Please note that your place in the Sixth Form could be at risk if you do not attend Enrolment.

When will lessons start? Lessons will start on Thursday 3rd September.
