## **Re: Music Department Spring Concert at St. Paul's Church, Blandford Road, St Albans, AL1 4JP**

We are looking forward to returning to St Paul's Church on **Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> March** for our spring concert at **7pm**. The evening will showcase performances from all our ensembles and will be a fitting way to celebrate the students' achievements this term.

Tickets are priced at £6.50 and can be purchased through your MCAS account, under your child's photograph in the Beaumont school shop section on the desktop version and in the Store section on the MCAS app. All funds from ticket sales support the provision of extra-curricular music at Beaumont and contribute to the associated performing costs (e.g. hiring the church, transport costs and purchasing music). Tickets are **limited to two per family until Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> February**. After this date, the limit will be removed and any remaining tickets will be made available to purchase.

Students involved in the concert will need to bring a packed lunch to school on 12<sup>th</sup> March. At 12.15pm, those in Years 7-11 will walk, accompanied by staff, to St. Paul's Church, where they will be joined by the upper year groups to rehearse until 3.25pm. Sixth Form students are welcome to walk with staff or may make their own travel arrangements and will be registered at the church. Students who play portable instruments will need to bring these with them to the church but larger instruments (double basses, cellos, timpani) will be transported in the school minibus.

Following the rehearsal, **all** students are required to make their own way home from the church with their belongings. **If you have any concerns, please contact the Music Department as soon as possible, by emailing [admin@beaumont.school](mailto:admin@beaumont.school), so that alternative arrangements can be made to accompany your child back to school.** Students should return to the church by 6.30pm wearing winter uniform (or smart, long, all-black for Sixth Form students).

Please note that St. Paul's Church has limited parking, though there is on-street parking nearby, and Morrisons car park is a short walk away. It is anticipated that the concert should finish by 8.30pm.

We look forward to celebrating the students' musical achievements with you.
