Uniform Reminders

We would like to take this opportunity to remind students of our uniform expectations, ready for the start of the summer term.

We have provided a summary of our uniform expectations below but you can find a full summary [here](#).

It is important that students are clearly either wearing **full uniform** or **summer uniform**, not a hybrid of the two. This is clearly shown on the website (linked above), but namely the combinations are:

Full Uniform

- Blazer, shirt and tie, trousers
- Blazer, blouse, skirt/trousers
- Students may opt to wear a jumper with the above combinations of full uniform. It does not replace our school blazer.

Summer Uniform

- Summer shirt (with logo) and trousers
- Summer shirt (with logo) and shorts
- Summer shirt (with logo) and skirt

Skirt length: if your child chooses to wear the skirt uniform, please ensure that their skirt is no more than 5cm above the knee.

Jewellery: students are permitted to wear one stud in each ear lobe. Hoops are not permitted. Additional piercings in any other part of the ear or face are not permitted. We would like to remind you that jewellery that is not part of our uniform policy will be confiscated. A full copy of general uniform matters can be found [here](#).

Footwear: Black, plain style; any laces should be black. Platform soles, boots, black trainers, black "trainer type", or shoes made of fabric such as canvas are not acceptable; the shoe should not cover the ankle bone. Shoes should have no prominent logos.

A few key reminders specifically about summer uniform:

- Shorts are intended for the hottest days when students would be too hot in trousers. Therefore, in line with the rest of the summer uniform, the shorts may not be worn with a jumper or blazer.
- Shorts are to be plain, black, tailored school shorts, worn with plain black ankle socks (not branded).
- Shorts are to be no shorter than 5cm above the knee.



On a related warm-weather note, in line with sun-safety guidance, students are permitted to wear sunhats in outdoor areas of the school; these should be plain in colour and any logos or motifs must be appropriate for the school setting.
