



Advice and Guidance on GCSE/Level 2 Results Day 2026 and Enrolment deadline

This page contains important information. You will need to read this carefully so that you are aware of how to get advice, if you need it, once you receive your results and how to enrol for the Sixth Form.

Getting advice on GCSE/Level 2 Results day - Thursday 20th August 2026

Staff will be available on Results day to answer any specific questions regarding Sixth Form enrolment. If you need advice and guidance once you've received your results, there will be members of LT and the Sixth Form team available to support you. Staff will be available from 09:00 until 13:00. Our Youth Connexions advisor will also be available to provide advice and guidance.

If you are currently at another school and have applied to us for Sixth Form, you can also come to the school in person to seek advice should you need it. Please report to [Main Reception](#) between 10:00 and 13:00 once you have collected your results from your current school. Please bring a copy of your Statement of Results with you.

Please note that the Sixth Form Office is not staffed during the school holidays and if you phone or email, your message may not be received until term starts. **The only day to meet for a discussion is on Results day between 09:00 and 13:00.** Any queries raised after this will be dealt with at Enrolment; please check the [website](#) for the timings of this day.

Entry criteria

Once you have received your results, please check carefully that you have met the [entry criteria](#) for your chosen subjects and confirm your choices on the Applicaa portal.

If you have not met the published criteria for one or more of your chosen subjects, please make alternative subject choice(s), for which you do meet the criteria, on the Applicaa portal.

If you want to change a subject, please check that you meet the entry criteria for your new choice and add it on the Applicaa portal.

Please note that we will not be able to confirm any subject changes before Enrolment day on Wednesday 2nd September. Many classes are full and we will only be able to ascertain where spaces have been freed up once we have processed all the forms, therefore, changes will be confirmed on Enrolment day.

Enrolment deadline

Please ensure that you [log into Applicaa](#) under 'Existing Users', complete your Enrolment Form and click on the 'Submit Enrolment Form' button before the deadline of 10am on Friday 21st August. Do this as soon as you can - do not wait until the last minute!

If you do not meet this deadline, we will have to release the spaces reserved for you on your chosen subjects to students on the waiting list, so please plan your availability to receive your results and to seek further guidance as necessary. If you subsequently get in touch, there may no longer be available spaces to offer you.
